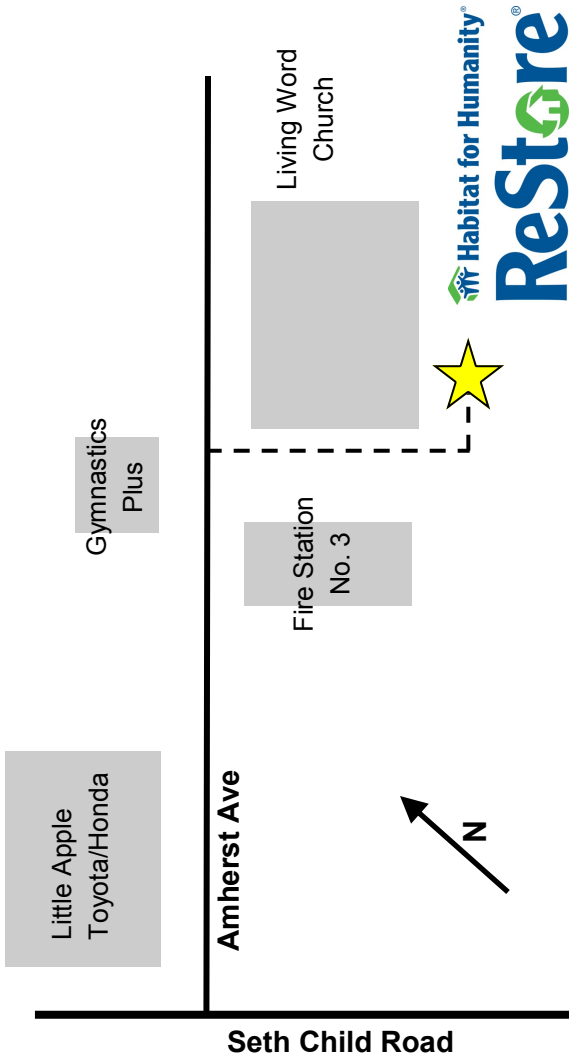

We graciously accept the following donations:

Appliances: working clothes washers, dryers, refrigerators, microwaves, stoves. Dishwashers under two years old.

Architectural Items: columns, antiques, mantles,
Carpet and Pad: new items only, please.

Countertops: good condition, minimal chips.

Doors: no broken glass, free of bowing, twisting, holes, gouges, water damage and splintering.

Electrical: usable light fixtures, ceiling fans, parts and supplies, no broken glass.

Flooring: new flooring; wood, ceramic, tile, vinyl.

Furniture: chairs, couches, tables, shelves, bed frames, etc.

Hardware: knobs, hinges, locks, nails, cabinet pulls, bolts, nuts, screws.

Insulation: new insulation only.

Kitchen and Bath: cabinets complete with doors/drawers and no damage.

Landscaping: patio and paving stones, bricks.

Lumber: de-nailed plywood, milled lumber, trim, siding. Free of rot/water damage and excessive twisting.

Masonry: cinder blocks, bricks, paving stones.

Paint: full unopened cans; paint or stain, latex only.

Plumbing: lead-free fixtures, parts, and supplies.

Plywood: half/full sheets in good condition.

Roofing Materials: full bundles; drip edge full lengths.

Siding: vinyl and aluminum, full boxes only.

Tools: hand, garden, and working power tools.

Windows: insulated glass, no broken glass.
