After the panel has sampled each entry, the remainder of the pie will be offered to Hoedown attendees as part of the purchasable sampler card!!! This can be great way for our entire community to come together to give a helping hand. See—my Grandma was right—pie does fix everything!

You can find entry forms at Manhattan Area Habitat for Humanity. Print one off and bring it and your pie to the Houston Street Ballroom on December 1, 2017! Pies must be brought in by 4pm to give the panel of pie judges time to savor your entries before the main event! Want to come back later to enjoy the party, and the competitions pie? We will be serving a BBQ meal to everyone who pays the cover charge of \$15, until the food runs out! So come early for to enjoy the BBQ, stay for the announcing of the winner, and for the two local bands that are going to be playing for our dance! If you want to try some of the other pies, to see how the competition stacks up—all of the pies, including the winners, will be available on a first come first serve basis for purchasers of the all access passes! Now, you might be thinking well, I just made pie, why would I want more? The All Access passes also get you sample size tastes (up to 8 samples per pass) of specialty beers and ciders!!!

It is a win win! A night of friends food and fun with all profits going to Manhattan Area Habitat for Humanity; helping families from Ogden to Wamego and everywhere else in the greater Manhattan area!
