

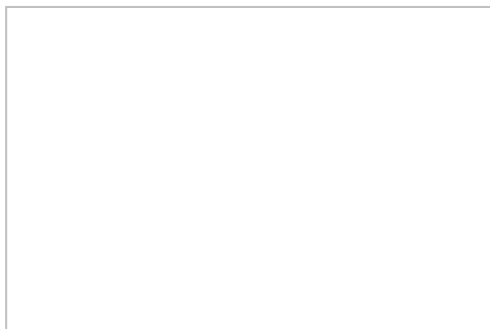

In 2017, for the first time in almost ten years, Manhattan Area Habitat for Humanity returns to Manhattan, Kansas to build [House #27, which will be built on the historic Yuma Street](#). Manhattan Area Habitat for Humanity, in partnership with Heritage Builders, intends to revitalize this neighborhood through our Rock The Block Manhattan 2017 initiative. This neighborhood "spruce up" will assist homeowners with needed exterior home repairs, maintenance, weatherization, safety, accessibility and landscaping.

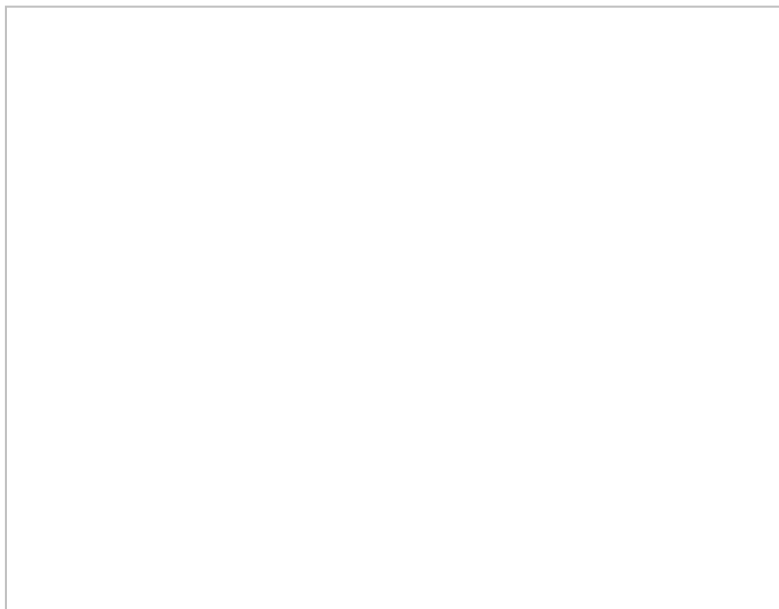

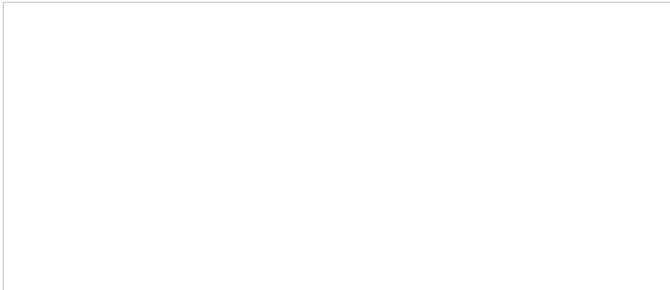
